1ZZ-FE is a very long-stroke engine, so further forcing by rpm was impossible with the same bore/stroke ratio. As a result, the bore was maximally increased so the wall thickness between cylinders was reduced to 5.5 mm. Thinner is impossible because gasket will not seal head/block joint.

The 1ZZ FE 1,794 cc engine from Toyota released in 1998 and ran to 2007. From 2000 the engine came with VVT-i which lifted power and improved the throttle response. The engine put out between 120-140 hp depending on whether it had the VVTi and higher compression design.

Toyota 3ZZ-FE engine reliability, problems and repair. In 2000 a 3ZZ-FE engine being the next generation after Toyota 4A. was introduced. The 3ZZ motor was a younger model of the 1ZZ and 2ZZ types. It was developed out of the 1ZZ-FE model having a crankshaft with a 81.5 mm decreased piston stroke installed inside the cylinder block.

The 1ZZ-FE engine had an all-alloy cylinder head with double overhead camshafts (Toyota's 'twin cam' design) and four valves per cylinder that were actuated by shimless bucket-type tappets.
