The American Alpine Institute's guide training program formed the basis of the AMGA's national certification program for alpine guides, and AAI guides have played leadership roles as the designers, instructors, and examiners in the rock, alpine and ski certification courses and exams.

### **Mountaineering Instructor Professional Training Program**

The AMGA is the sole representative in the US for the International Federation of Mountain Guides Associations (IFMGA) and Climbing Instructor Certifications (endorsed by the UIAA). The AMGA is recognized worldwide as the highest American standard of training and certification for instructors and guides. AMGA certification is the standard in the United States.

The MTS school of guides in the USA require aspirants complete 5-6 years of intensive training and charges 24 000 usd. The diploma is often issued after 10 years of intensive practice. The mountain guiding culture emerged in Europe in the 19 century when Alpine climbing was officially recognized as a sport discipline.
