If the teeth characteristics of a skull are strictly those of a herbivore, we consider the animal to be a prey species. There is another skull characteristic that is very useful in determining predator/prey classification. This is the location of the orbits (eye sockets.) Most all predators have the eyes located in a forward position on the skull.
