How Often to Change Transmission Fluid: Manual and Automatic

It is recommended to change transmission fluid every 30,000-50,000 miles in your manual transmission Toyota Corolla (see maintenance schedule). Follow this picture guide to perform this maintenance item; most people I talk to agree it is even easier than an oil change!. How Often Should I Change My Transmission Fluid?

Changing the transmission fluid can extend the life of your transmission even if the fluid is still red when you check it by pulling out the dip stick. If the fluid is dark red or brown and smells burned, you should flush the transmission completely. There may be significant damage to the transmission.

Most manufacturers suggest 30,000 to 60,000 miles as the point at which you should change the transmission fluid in a manual transmission. However, vehicles with transmissions that are under 'high stress' should change the transmission fluid every 15,000 miles.

In many cases, a transmission fluid exchange is due every 30,000 miles or 2 years.

How Do You Know When Your Transmission Fluid Needs to Be ...

Insert the tube of your fluid transfer pump into the transmission fluid fill plug. Continue adding fluid until it starts to just dribble out. This should be approximately 3.5 quarts. Replace the fill plug and let the car idle again until this new fluid reaches the proper temperature range.
