EGG DROP COMPETITION GUIDELINES - STEM

Build your container and place the egg inside. Drop the egg from someplace high. (Be sure it's safe and an adult is with you.) After you drop it look and see if your egg cracked or remained intact. (Remember to wash your hands after touching raw egg!)

All scores will be determined using the Egg Drop Competition Official Rules equations. The goal of the egg drop competition is to obtain the lowest non-zero score. Any egg drop that results in the egg breaking receives a score of zero. All devices will be dropped from the same height. 3.
