One of the weaknesses of risk assessment is the fact that "part of the difficulty is that the potential harm and risk implied by the term dangerousness is generally treated as a dichotomous variable (either present or absent) rather than as the continuum each really is" (Ackerman, pg. 145, 1999).

## **Risk Assessment - Issues in Forensic Psychology**

The current group of risk assessment tools either provide a probabilistic estimate of violence risk in a specified time period (actuarial instruments), or allow for a professional judgment to be made on risk level (for example, low, moderate, or high) after taking into account the presence or absence of a predetermined set of factors (structured clinical judgment instruments).

## **Use of risk assessment instruments to predict violence and ...**

It is the most empirically supported actuarial method for the assessment of violence risk in forensic populations. The VRAG is a 12-item actuarial instrument that assesses the risk of violent recidivism among men apprehended for criminal violence.
