Tips for Improving Your Child's Reading Skills: For a 4th ...

Hold up all ten fingers, then put the one you're multiplying by 9 down (if you're doing 9×6 then put your thumb down on your right hand). The number of fingers that will be left standing on your left hand represent the digit in the tens place (5), the number of fingers left up on your left hand represent the digit in the ones place (4).
