Ida Jean Orlando-Pelletier (August 12, 1926 - November 28, 2007) was an internationally known psychiatric health nurse, theorist and researcher who developed the "Deliberative Nursing Process Theory."

Ida Jean Orlando was a nursing theorist who is credited with the nursing process theory. She used her own research to come up with this theory that the nurse's role is to "find out and meet the patient's immediate need for help" (Current Nursing).

Ida Jean Orlando - Theory of Nursing Process Discipline Orlando's theory was developed in the late 1950s from observations she recorded between a nurse and patient. Despite her efforts, she was only able to categorize the records as "good" or "bad" nursing.
