Start the engine and again press down the clutch. Move the gear lever into the first gear. When the gear is engaged, you will hear a slight click.

Place the shift lever into first gear, which on a six-speed manual will always be to the left and up. Second gear is straight down from first, third is up and over to the right a little, fourth is straight back down from third, fifth is up and over to the right a little and sixth is straight down from fifth.

### How to Drive a Six-Speed Manual Transmission | It Still Runs

Grinding gears will result in a grating sound as you shift between gears. If this is the case, the trouble may be in your synchronizers. Synchronizers are positioned between the two main drive gears and are responsible for locking the gears into the correct speed with the engine.

### **How to Troubleshoot a Manual Transmission That Will Not Shift**

At every gear change you have to press and release the clutch twice, hence the name "double-clutching." You can also see how a small linear motion in the gear shift knob allows you to change gears. The gear shift knob moves a rod connected to the fork. The fork slides the collar on the yellow shaft to engage one of two gears.

Put the gear shift in the neutral position when traffic stops or slows to a crawl. If you're moving too slow in 1st gear, the engine could stall. Engage the clutch, shift the gear shift into neutral, and release the clutch to keep the engine in neutral. Let the vehicle roll and use your breaks to slow it down or stop if you need to.

In most vehicles with manual transmission, gears are selected by manipulating a lever called a gear stick, shift stick, gearshift, gear lever, gear selector, or shifter connected to the transmission via linkage or cables and mounted on the floor, dashboard, or steering column. Moving the lever forward, backward, left, and right into specific positions selects particular gears.
