A RIT score is an estimation of a student's instructional level and also measures student progress or growth in school. What RIT Scores might I see for my students? As a teacher it is helpful to have a general idea of what RIT scores are typical for Math, Reading, and Language Usage for the grade level of your students. NWEA's Normative Data charts the average RIT score for Fall and Spring testing for students at each grade level.

RIT Scores - For the Teachers

MaP-Testing is an independent and voluntary testing program for toilet models. MaP (Maximum Performance) Scores represent the number of grams of solid waste (soybean paste and toilet paper) that a toilet model can flush and remove completely from the fixture in a single flush.

Based on 2011 RIT Norms, LO is equal to percentile scores <33; HI is equal to percentile scores > 66; and AV is equal to percentile scores between 33 and 66.
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
