The Montessori Approach to Early Childhood Education ...

In Montessori schools, the program is so far from “one-size-fits-all” education that even grade levels are flexible, grouped by developmental range instead of chronological age. This allows children to learn at their own pace, and the classroom instruction is structured in such a way that students are able to complete tasks before moving on, giving them a sense of accomplishment.
