

Nonfiction Text Features Labels

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It's disappointing that there's no convenient menu that lets you just browse freebies. Instead, you have to search for your preferred genre, plus the word 'free' (free science fiction, or free history, for example). It works well enough once you know about it, but it's not immediately obvious.

Nonfiction Text Features Labels

A Nonfiction Text is any text that contains true or factual information... Nonfiction Text Features are the features that help a reader to navigate a Nonfiction Text more easily. Examples of Nonfiction Text Features include...Table of Contents, Headings, Bold Words, Captions, Photographs, Graphs, Charts, Illustrations, Glossary, and Index.

You can also put the different non-fiction text features up on chart paper and then students can go around and find different examples of each text feature and put examples.

Explain that students will now become detectives as they look through nonfiction texts to find information using these text features: table of contents, headings, glossary, and labels. Pass out grade-appropriate nonfiction texts to the students in pairs and have them remain on the rug to work.
