For the ORQ and PSQ scales, high scores suggest significant levels of occupational stress and psychological strain, respectively. T scores at or above 70 indicate a strong probability of maladaptive stress, debilitating strain, or both. Scores in the range of 60-69 suggest mild levels of maladaptive stress and strain.

The Occupational Stress Index (OSI) is an additive burden model, which focuses on work stressors relevant to the cardiovascular system (Belkic 1995(a)). The OSI incorporates elements of the Job Strain Model (Karasek 1979), as well as other formulations of how stress leads to cardiovascular disease, such as features of work in high-risk occupations.
