to compounds used to treat diabetes that slows the progression of Parkinson's disease and its symptoms in mice. In experiments performed with cultures of human brain cells and live mouse models, they report the drug, called NLY01, blocked the degradation of brain cells that is the hallmark of Parkinson's disease.
