The procedure takes pressure off the spinal cord or a spinal nerve in cases such as a lumbar stenosis, a herniated disc or bone spur. A laminectomy can be performed at any level of the spine and using minimally invasive techniques. Patients with single-level or two-level stenosis of the lumbar spine are usually sent home on the day of surgery.
