In-text references should immediately follow the title, word, or phrase to which they are directly relevant, rather than appearing at the end of long clauses or sentences. In-text references should always precede punctuation marks.

Properly citing a book can be one of the most frustrating parts of writing an essay, term paper or research paper. Whenever you use a quote, you must properly cite it within the paper and list the source in the bibliography at the end of the paper.

EasyBib: How to cite a book in APA

For entries in encyclopedias, dictionaries, and other reference works, cite the entry name as you would any other work in a collection but do not include the publisher information. Also, if the reference book is organized alphabetically, as most are, do not list the volume or the page number of the article or item.

Do You Underline Book Titles? Italicize? Put inside Quote ...

When a book, paper, or article has no identifiable author, cite it as Anon. Year, e.g., (Anon. 1996) (Anon. is the abbreviation for anonymous). See Full Citation. If you want reference a paper found in another article, do so as follows: (Driblick 1923, in Oobleck 1978).

How to Reference Books and Articles in Text Before computers, we used typewriters to underline book titles, and we placed quotation marks around article titles. However, many current style manuals recommend italicizing book titles and magazine names (impossible to do on a typewriter) and using quotation marks around articles.

How to Cite a Book in APA - Referencing a Book in Your Paper Use the author-date system for in-text citation. Separate multiple works with a semi-colon. Format titles referred to in your text correctly. Add page numbers for quotations or paraphrases.

APA's Publication Manual (2010) indicates that, in the body of your paper, you should use italics for the titles of: Beyond APA's specific examples, know that certain types of titles are almost always written in italics. Use italics in a word-processed document for the types of titles you'd underline if you were writing by hand.

How to Reference Books and Articles in Text - Grammar and ...

In this citation, there is a general format in referencing through endnotes/footnotes, in-text, and reference pages. Academic papers in APA citation has general writing guidelines. Papers should be typed, double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11") with 1" margins on all sides. You should use a clear font that is highly readable.

How to Cite a Book - Chicago Provide the name of the author or authors. Add the title of the book in italics. Close with publication information. Adjust your format when writing in-text footnotes.

How to Write Guide: How to Cite Other Papers in Your Paper

If you are directly quoting from a work, include the author, year of publication, and the page number for the reference (preceded by "p."). Introduce the quotation with a signal phrase that includes the author's last name followed by the date of publication in parentheses.

Reference List: Books. APA (American Psychological Association) style is most commonly used to cite sources within the social sciences. This resource, revised according to the 6 th edition, second printing of the APA manual, offers examples for the general format of APA research papers, in-text citations, endnotes/footnotes, and the reference page.

How to Cite a Book Online in MLA Include the same information as a regular book. Add as much as the original publication information as possible. After citing the original publication information, add the electronic publication information.

APA (American Psychological Association) - Citation Guide ...

Create a list of references, one for each item cited in the paper, in a section called "References". This section goes at the end of your paper. The references are to be alphabetized by the fist author's last name, or (if no author is listed) the organization or title.

How to Cite a Research Paper: APA, MLA, ASA, Chicago ...

Citations of books in your Reference List should begin with the last name of the book's author, then the author's initials. Next, write the year of publication within parentheses. After the year, list the title of the book in sentence case -- only capitalize the first word of the title and subtitle, if applicable, just as if you were writing a sentence.

Referencing Books In A Paper

The basic structure of a book reference should list the author's last name, first initials, publication year, book title, location, and publisher. Your reference should appear as follows: Author, I. N. (Year).
