The Arctic Circle Trail is not inherently dangerous, but it is suitable only for experienced trekkers. It is a long-distance and very remote trek so preparation is key. The major challenges include carrying a heavy pack for long periods filled with all the food and supplies required for at least seven days in the backcountry.

The Arctic Circle Trail is a long-distance footpath in Greenland. It runs from the inland settlement of Kangerlussuaq to the town of Sisimiut on the west coast. The trail is 165km long and usually takes between seven and 10 days to complete. Greenland is larger than Mexico and is in fact the largest island in the world.

Into the mountains, along deep cut ice fjords - trekking and hiking in Greenland is available in July & August. Adventure is always available in Greenland, but most activities are offered from February to April or June to September. The coastal ship braves the seas all year, though most sailing tours run from June to September.

The Arctic Circle Trail is a breathtaking expanse of Greenland backcountry. The low Arctic vegetation climbs up the sides of mountains as the terrain grows steeper near the coast. Located about 30 miles north of the Arctic Circle, the typical route stretches 102 miles (165km) from Kangerlussuaq International Airport to the fishing village of Sisimiut on the West coast. It's possible to lengthen the trip to 124 miles by starting from Greenland's ice cap for those who are up for the challenge.
